\*\* Attendees wishing to enjoy different types of alcoholic beverages or more than sample size must still bring their own drinks to the event.



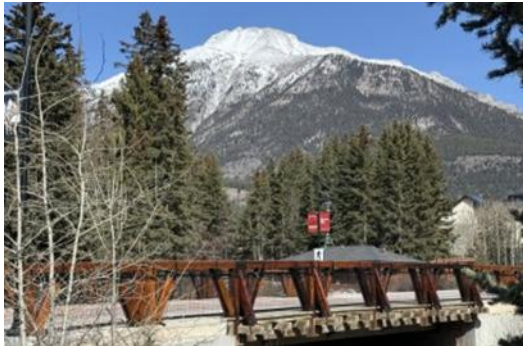
### Sunday April 12 Masters Golf Final Round
