An open letter to my neighbours in Spring Creek: From Dr. Jonathan Fridhandler Owner and Medical Director, Spring Creek Integrated Health

I am a proud resident of Spring Creek and I am thrilled to be opening a new medical clinic to serve our community.

In the last few years we have continued to witness a slow drain of our local physicians. We currently have over 2,000 people on our wait list who are in need of a family doctor.

My goal is to provide primary and specialist care to every resident in Spring Creek and as many as we can in the Bow Valley. In order to do this we need to recruit new family doctors!

We all know that Canmore is an amazing place to live and work, but the single biggest barrier to recruiting young family doctors is that they simply cannot afford to live here early on in their career.

This is not a problem that the local or provincial government will be able to solve for us. In fact, provincial supports intended to help recruit doctors to smaller communities are not offered in our town.

We now have a beautiful clinic that any doctor would be proud to work in but I need the community's help to provide housing solutions.

If anybody in Spring Creek has housing that can be affordably provided to family doctors on a short, medium or long term basis, please reach out to me and together we can make sure that all of our families have access to the care we need.
